

EXHIBITION & ENTRY DETAILS

QUALIFICATIONS: There is no entry fee, although you must be a member to submit a piece. Adult memberships start at \$55 per year.

ENTIRES will be accepted during the listed "ENTRY DATES" from 9:00am-5:00pm. We will accept the first 45-50 two-dimensional pieces, pending number of large pieces entered. Unlimited three-dimensional works will be accepted. Members and faculty may enter one piece. There is no size restriction. Member entries could be juried by Art Students League faculty, depending on space.

GUIDELINES: Pieces must be framed on a stretched canvas with a wire on back for hanging. Include name and title of piece on back of artwork. Artwork must be wrapped in paper or bubble wrap when dropped off. Paper/bubble wrap will not be returned.

To be considered for use in promotional materials, email a digital image (at least 300 dpi and 4" wide) and its title to marketing@asld.org no later than the date noted.
