The Art Students League of Denver will award scholarships, when available, to attend our Saturday morning or afternoon visual art classes or workshops for youths from age 5 through 18. The intent of these scholarships is to provide equal access to education in the visual arts for youth who have a strong desire to learn but lack the financial means to afford our classes.

Each scholarship includes: 2 months of visual arts education and the use of League art supplies for any Ongoing Youth class and membership for one year. The League reserves the right to award scholarships at its own discretion. There is no cash value for scholarships, and we do not offer credits or transfers.

Scholarships do not include transportation to and from the ASLD or snacks. Applicants must be Colorado residents. You may apply for a scholarship at any time. Submit applications to the ASLD address below. Awards will be made as applications are submitted, based on space available, until all funds are used. Recipients and their instructors will be asked to complete an evaluation after completion of the scholarship.
