PHOTOGRAPHY OF MODELS POLICY FOR STUDENTS & FACULTY

EFFECTIVE APRIL 30, 2009

Models employed by the Art Students League of Denver must give their permission for faculty members and students to photograph them only during studio sessions for instructed classes. No permission is granted to photograph a nude model. The photographs are to be used solely as a resource or reference for artwork initiated in instructed classes.

No photographs may be published in any medium without the model's express permission. This includes all print and electronic media now known or that shall be created in the future. Prior to publication, the student or faculty member agrees to provide negotiated, monetary compensation for the publication of the model's image(s).

To preserve the model's privacy, no photographs are permitted to be taken during the model's breaks or at any time that the model is not formally modeling for the instructed class. **No photographs of a model can be taken during any Uninstructed Figure Studies classes—no exceptions!** There is to be **no tipping** of models at the Art Students League.

It is the policy of the Art Students League of Denver that no model may be photographed on the Art Students League of Denver's property outside an instructed class' formal modeling session for any student's or faculty member's personal use.
